WHEREAS, the State of Tennessee enacted the Fire Department Recognition Act, and

WHEREAS, any entity or organization desiring to operate as a fire department for purposes of suppressing fires, performing rescue services, or for other emergency response purposes, shall file and application for Certificate of Recognition with the Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance, state fire marshal's office, and file a renewal application to continue so operating, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Tennessee Code Annotated 68-102-306, no fire department may be recognized in the State of Tennessee without the approval of the local governing body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hawkins County Board of Commissioners that John Murnane is authorized to file an application for recognition on behalf of the Hawkins County Hazmat Team with Tennessee Department of Commerce and Insurance, state fire marshal's office for the purpose of suppressing fires, performing rescue services, or for other emergency response purposes within the boundaries of Hawkins County with exception of Kingsport.
