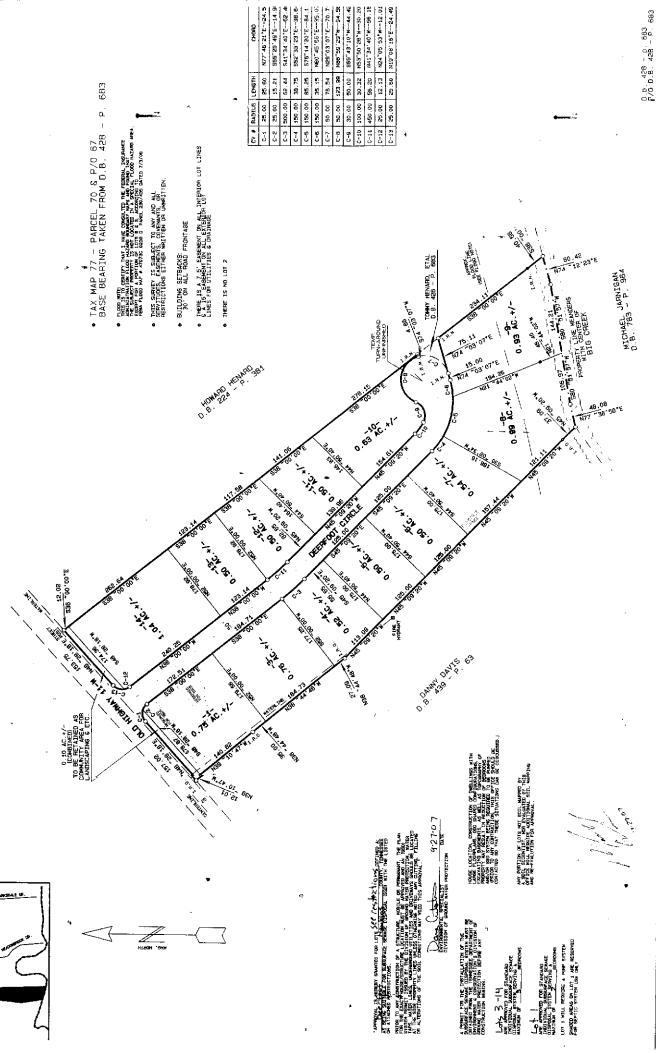

AMENDMENT TO FIXED ASSETS POLICY FOR HAWKINS COUNTY REGARDING ROADS AND BRIDGES

WHEREAS, in October 2002, Hawkins County Commission approved a General Fixed Assets Policy for Hawkins County as required by the new financial reporting guidelines established by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board, generally referred to as GASB Statement 34. Such policy was amended in February 2003.

Now, however, as the Hawkins County Highway Department prepares certain information regarding infrastructure (roads and bridges) for audit purposes and, in order to become compliant with GASB Statement 34, it has been determined that our policy should be further amended for better clarification of said policy.

The following shall be changed: Accounting Policies. A. Capitalization and Depreciation

The dollar value for Roads and Bridges shall be \$25,000 instead of the current \$5,000

The following is for clarification and is in compliance with GASB Statement 34 guidelines:

Hawkins County will initially capitalize its Roads and Bridges infrastructure by the following methods:

#### Roads

- Hawkins County will retroactively report roads at actual or estimated historical cost back to July 1, 1980, or
- The first time the road was upgraded on or after July 1, 1980 (gravel to chip and seal, chip and seal to paved) or
- The last time the road was replaced or resurfaced in a way that it extended the original useful life of the road (i.e.
  not considered routine maintenance) on or after July 1, 1980.

#### Bridges

- Hawkins County will retroactively report bridges at actual or estimated historical cost back to July 1, 1980, or
- The last time the bridge was upgraded (wood to concrete, ect.) if this date was on or after July 1, 1980.
- Major renovations on or after July 1, 1980 that was not considered routine repairs that extended the original useful life of the bridge, will be capitalized.

Certain roads and bridges constructed prior to July 1, 1980 that meet certain criteria will not be capitalized.

Acquired/Construction Date: This will be based on as much documentary evidence that can be found to support the acquired/construction date (e.g. resolutions passed by County Commission, historical records, County Highway construction programs). In addition, the County may interview Road Department personnel that have been working on County roads and bridges for a number of years.
